



















15th Annual 5K Run/Walk for Autism May 27, 2017

For over 25 years, the Autism Society Central Virginia, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, has served as the region's premier source of education, advocacy, services, and support for individuals with autism, their families and friends, and interested professionals. Autism is a developmental disability that occurs in all racial, ethnic, and socioeconomic groups. Many individuals with autism have significant social, communication, and behavioral challenges. The prevalence rate of autism continues to rise, and currently, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC, 2016) estimates that an average of 1 in 68 children (1 in 42 boys) in the United States has autism. There is no known cause or cure for autism at this time.

The Autism Society Central VA is committed to meaningful participation and self-determination in all aspects of life for individuals with autism and their families, at any age and any stage. To fulfill our mission to improve the lives of all affected by autism by maximizing the self- sufficiency, independence, and quality of life for all living with autism, the Autism Society Central Virginia offers...

The 5K Run/Walk is one of the Autism Society Central Virginia's primary sources of income, raising over \$100,000 in May 2016.
