We offer two distinct programs based on the principles of applied behavior analysis (ABA). Home-based services provide ABA therapy in the home to help children and adolescents build critical skills and reduce problem behaviors. Center-based services provide ABA training on location to help children build skills and reduce problem behaviors. • The center currently has openings for its home-based services and is now accepting applications for the new center-based program. The center accepts many commercial and private insurances, as well as private pay. Parents whose children attend the center receive parent coaching and consultation. Consultation focuses on teaching caregivers to work with their children to reduce problematic behavior and generalize, or transfer, skills they learn at the center to their home setting. The center continues to provide ABA training and consultation services to local school districts to increase expertise and enhance student outcomes.

- PEERS® for Adolescents Social Skills Group, developed by UCLA's Dr. Elizabeth Laugeson, is a 14 week evidence-based social skills intervention for motivated students who are interested in learning new ways of making and keeping friends. During each group session, teens are taught important social skills and are given the opportunity to practice these skills in session during socialization activities. Parents attend separate sessions at the same time and are taught how to assist their teens in making and keeping friends by helping to expand their teen's social network, and providing feedback through coaching during weekly socialization homework assignments. Parent participation is required.
