We offer a wide range of impactful programs, including social and recreational activities, support groups, educational workshops, advocacy initiatives, and scholarships. Position Overview:

The RVA Duck Race & Festival of Inclusion Mascot Performer entertains and engages individuals at events by performing various activities such as meeting and greeting children and adults, participating in event activities, and taking pictures with attendees to enhance their experience. The chosen candidate will embody the spirit of the Mascot and will have the physical stamina and enthusiasm to perform for up to several hours at a time.

Responsibilities:

- Perform as the Mascot at the annual Duck Race & Festival of Inclusion, other ASCV events, and/or local events as scheduled
- Interact with community members and create an exciting and fun atmosphere
- Attend community events and represent ASCV as a positive role model
- Maintain the costume in good condition and inform ASCV of any repairs or replacements needed
- Preserve the identity of the Mascot without deviating from established character, including body language, mannerisms, attitude, etc.
- Follow all safety rules and regulations while performing

Requirements:

- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Cannot be over 6' tall due to costume size and fit
- Previous experience as a Mascot is preferred
- Physical stamina and ability to perform for extended periods of time
- Ability to work in outdoor weather conditions, including heat
- Outgoing and playful personality
- Enthusiasm to interact with children and adults in the autism community
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- o Provide own transportation to and from events
